ITO's have a legislated mandate to produce a Strategic Training Plan (STP) for their industry. It is intended that ESITO produces an STP for two key stakeholder groups.

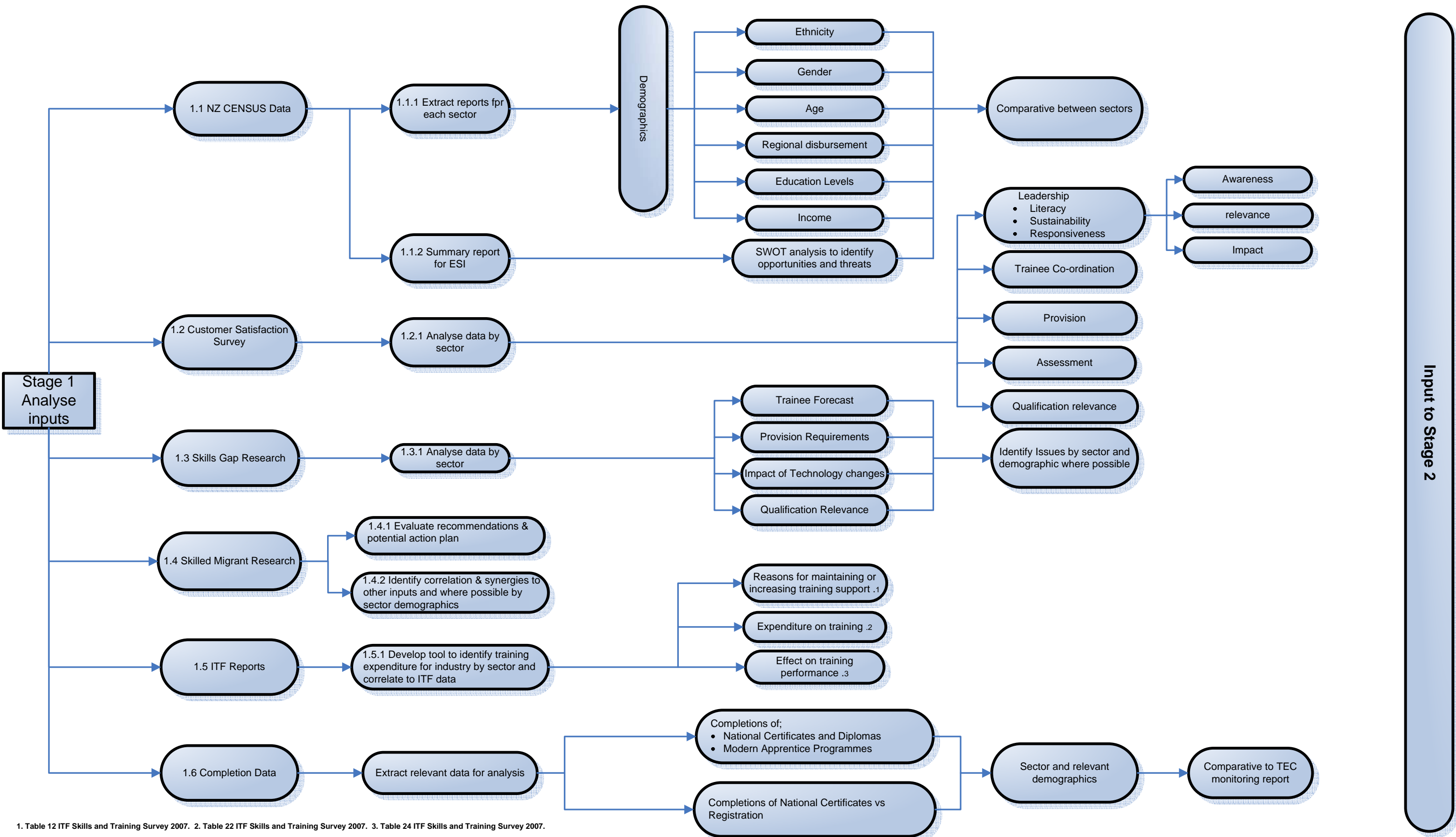

Industry

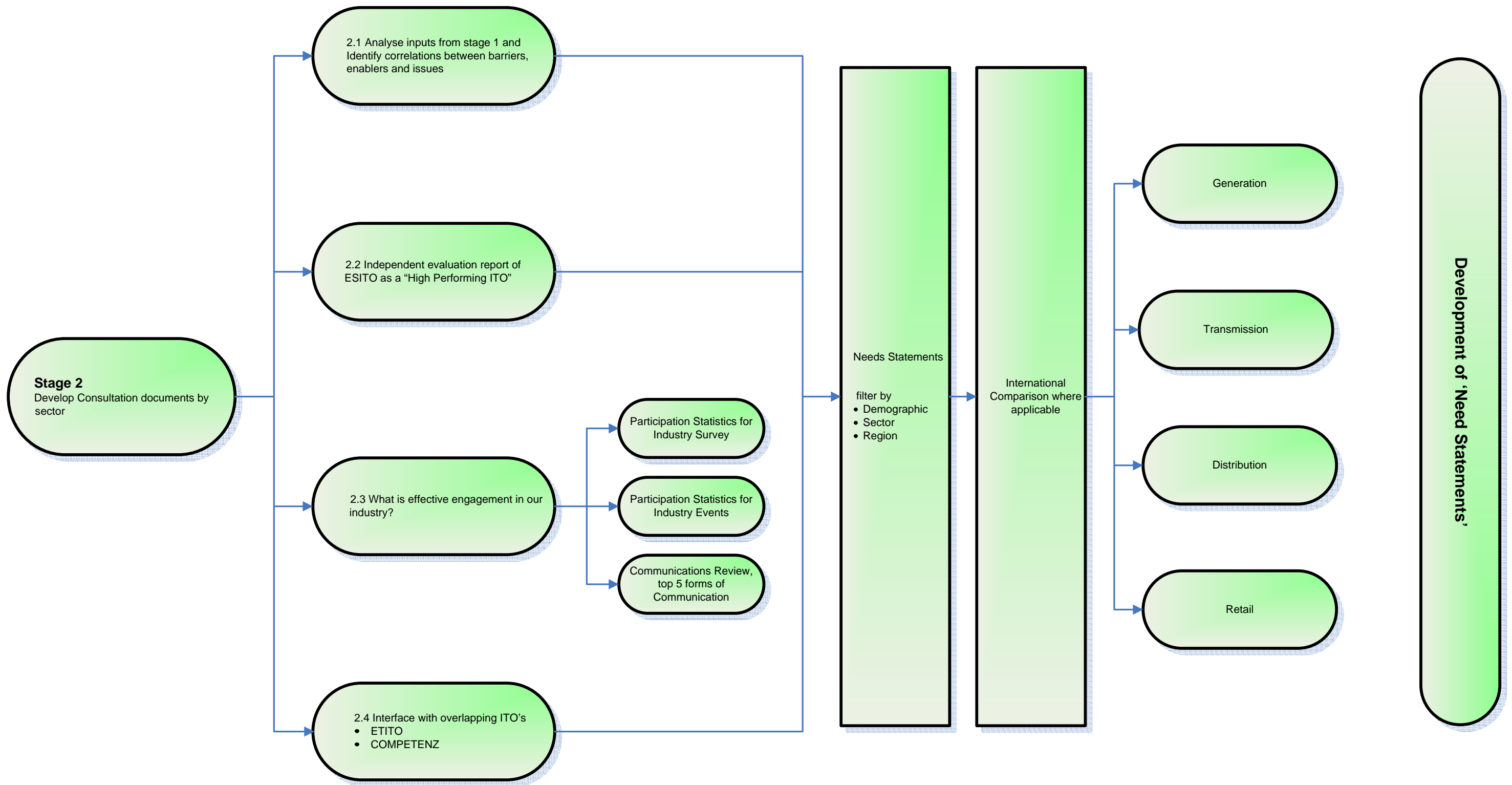
The STP will be a high level strategic plan to address both immediate and long term 'needs'. 'Needs' can best be described as skills, training and wider workforce development issues. In addition it will be segmented into industry sectors to create greater relevance and contextualise the need. From this ESITO will identify key issues and outcomes for the Industry.

Government Funding Agencies

The Tertiary Education Commission is ESITO's primary government funding agency. It is envisaged that STP will provide a clear endorsement of Industry's needs articulated as key issues and outcomes. In turn these will inform our investment strategy and provide the basis for engagement with our Investment Manager.
